Anyone who lives in District 19 (Auburndale, Bayside, Bay Terrace, Beechurst, College Point, Douglaston, Little Neck, Malba, North Flushing and Whitestone) and is at least 16 years old can vote the week of March 26<sup>th</sup> - April 3<sup>rd</sup> even if you're not registered or eligible to vote in electoral elections.
